Project Scope:

LAN provided architectural and engineering services, to the Fairlawn Board of Education, for an addition to the existing Warren Point Elementary School. The addition included the construction of two new kindergarten classrooms, two small group instruction rooms, a large Media Center with a computer room, and a Child Study Team Office. Interior renovations consisted of providing a handicapped accessible building entrance, toilet facilities and nurse's office, and converting the existing media center to a standard classroom.

Measures were taken to match the brickwork of the existing building as closely as possible, with special attention paid to the ornate brick corbelling at the building's parapet. Attention to detail provided a seamless transition between new and existing construction.
