## Project Scope:

In an effort to meet the needs of the community population growth and high enrollment, a 7,000 sq. ft. addition to the existing school facility was planned. The addition consists of a kindergarten and science classroom located adjacent to the existing block of academic classrooms. A library media center and multipurpose room with a full-service kitchen are the major building program elements. The use of natural light enhances the quality of the interior spaces, promoting an excellent environment for teaching and learning.

The separation of major events allows greater use, control and flexibility of the building. Another important design element was site accessibility for vehicular traffic. There was a need to separate vehicular circulation for students drop off, teachers and buses as well as service/delivery vehicles. Installing an access road for buses, at the rear of the elementary school, offered a dramatic approach to the addition.
